

## ABOUT THE TRANSIT CENTER PROJECT

Originally built in 1939 to facilitate rail travel across the lower deck of the Bay Bridge, the old Transbay Terminal could no longer accommodate the region's current and future transportation needs. The Transbay Transit Center Project will replace the old Transbay Terminal with a multi-modal transportation center—the "Grand Central of the West"—which will serve 11 transit systems including: AC Transit, Amtrak, BART, Caltrain, Golden Gate Transit, Greyhound, Muni, Paratransit, SamTrans, WestCat Lynx, and future California High-Speed Rail. This project is managed by the Transbay Joint Powers Authority, a historic collaboration of Bay Area government and transportation agencies. ## WE'RE ON THE MOVE...ONE MORE TIME!

As of December 11, 2010, the final build-out of the Temporary Terminal will be complete. All AC Transit buses will move inside the Temporary Terminal on December 11, 2010. Muni will move its buses to their updated stops on December 16, 2010. Please note that move dates are subject to change due to inclement weather that could cause delays in our construction schedule. The Temporary Terminal will continue to accommodate AC Transit, Golden Gate Transit, Greyhound, Muni, SamTrans and WestCAT Lynx while the new Transbay Transit Center is under construction at First and Mission streets.

The Temporary Terminal will serve as home to these transit providers until the completion of the Transbay Transit Center in 2017.

## ABOUT THE TEMPORARY TERMINAL

Bounded by Main, Beale, Folsom and Howard streets, the Temporary Terminal is an open air bus terminal located in downtown San Francisco in close proximity to the Financial District, Embarcadero BART/Muni station, Market Street, the Ferry Building and AT&T Park.

Bus lines will operate inside the Temporary Terminal and on the perimeter of the new facility.

## THE TEMPORARY TERMINAL WILL FEATURE:

- Kiosks with real-time digital schedule information
- 24-hour security
- Overhead canopies and windscreens to protect passengers
- Three convenient entrances

### ENTRANCE TO THE TEMPORARY TERMINAL

As of December 11, 2010, there will be three entrances to the Temporary Terminal. In addition to the current entrance on Main Street, two additional entrances have been added—one on Howard Street between Main and Beale streets, and one on Beale Street between Howard and Folsom streets.

For your own safety, please use the crosswalks when entering the Temporary Terminal and please be mindful of bus traffic.

### BUS STOP LOCATIONS

For the final configuration of the Temporary Terminal, all AC Transit buses, except Line 800 All Nighter service, will be located inside the Temporary Terminal along with Greyhound and WestCat Lynx.

Golden Gate Transit, Muni, SamTrans, and Paratransit will be located curbside around the perimeter of the Temporary Terminal.

### FARE PAYMENT

Fares will continue to be paid in the same way as they are currently paid on all transit operators.
